



The ICICLE program enables you to set up a series of icons and menu bars and assign commands or text to them. When a chosen icon is activated the command is carried out or the text is written out.

A sophisticated printer spooler/manager is also available at any time and the routines are designed to multi-task with other programs including the Psion packages. Note that the routine takes about 20k of memory so extra memory will be required to run with the Psion programs but ICICLE will run with Basic or an Editor/Assembler program on a standard QL.

The versions on the carridge are set up to run with the Quill word processer and for Basic but versions for the other programs can be created using the install, program.

Note that < ENTER > denotes the pressing of the ENTER key in this text

GETTING STARTED :

ICICLE can be run from the ICE derktop by 'CLICKING' the boot program. As some of the routines will overwrite the ICICLE files you must use a back-up version and keep the original in reserve. Choose the copy option from the boot meant and make a back-up before using the routines.

The actual ICICLE exec files should not be 'CLICKED' and to run ICICLE without the desk top use the direct command:

exec indvl_basic_ICICLE < ENTER >

Once the routine is loaded a screen will display a start message and then clear. The routine can now be used by pressing CTRL+Z (user definable) for ICE users or 'CLICKING' the righthand mouse button for fortunate mouse owners. CTRL + K (user definable) will kill the routine permanently so be exercive of this one!

To avoid having two ICE pointers on the screen the routine will not activate if the ICE desk top is in use. If a new version of ICICLE is exected then the current version is automatically killed off thus preventing confusion if multiple copys are running.

SPOOLER DEFAULTS

The BAUD rate and the device names can be changed from the ICICLE_install program menu with :

< B > set Band and default drives

The supplied version Baud rate is 9600 and this can be changed to sult your printer if required. This hand rate is used only if it is not changed from Basic so you can incorporate a different BAUD rate in your boot program if required.

The first 6 default drive names are the list for the spouler dir option. The first one-will also become the EDIT default name eg. if you make the first name fipl then the EDIT name will also be fipl. If you wish to leave a name the install program.

STOP CURRENT SPOOL

Will stop the spool in progess if you change your mind and wish to stop printing or copying.

SPOOL TASK I-S FREE

If you click one of the 5 Task menu option you will be placed in the select a file to apool mode for the spool task number (1 to 5) you have chosen. If you wish to spool a file that is on model just 'CLICK' the dir model menu bar and 'then click the required file. This file will then be the file to apool from. Next just added to the list at required. To remove a file from the list 'CLICK' the EDIT task will be removed. The EDIT mode can also be used to select differnt edevice names from those displayed on the menu bars eg. raml_may_lis to inspect a file. Files can be added or taken (on the list while the spooler is pooling. If he spooler can also be used to a small window to funning as long as the task you with to change is not the one that is currently to disk etc.

SPOOLING QUILL_doc files

To spool a Quill file from within Quill a _ lis file must first be produced by Quill. This is done by loading the required _ doc file and selecting the Quill print

option and when you are prompted for the printer type in the required file name eg. mdv2_test this will produce a file in the required format for the spooler with the name test_lis (the _lis is added by Quill) This filename can then be added to the spool task list and spooled when you start the spooler.

SPECIAL TRANSLATE OPTION

Quill 2.3 has 10 translates to enable different characters from those displayed to be sent to the printer. This is often not enough and the spooler will fetch any number of translates from a Basic string 'trans'. This option only applies if the spooler is printing to a printer or copying to the screen. For spooling file to file the option is disabled. The format of the string is:

Edited in this way, If you use the UP / DOWN cursor keys you can move to your required icon number. The format of the strings is a 255 start marker followed by the icon number and then the user defined text eg. line 210 (icon 2) is:

Icons 1 to 54 are in similar program lines and are EDITed in the same way

The 3 muster icons on the bottom row (LOAD MERGE IMPORT) in the quill version are special in that they will do a directory, choose a file and then add this filename on to your command string. This allows the mouse to be used to load and merge files.

The 3 master icons on the bottom row can also be redefined by EDITIES program lines 800 to 870 eg.

\$00 user_15~CHRS(240)&T

< T > set default spool task 1

This option will allow you to redefine the spooler task 1 to your chosen filenames. This is used for spooling often used files and will save you time when spooling.

< B > set Baud and default drives

This option is described in the spooler section and is not required if you are not changing the spooler defaults.

PRINTER SPOOLER / MANAGER

The spooler enables you to spool a list of up to 5 files to your printer or to a microdrive or disk. The spooler operates as a low you carry on with a different operation. MAIN MENU:

ESCAPE

will return you to the program you were in when you activated the spooler.

TART SPOCLER

Starts up the spooler if there are files to spool. If you require to watch the progress of the spooler the pointer should be left outside the main menu window and the progress will be updated as the files spool. If you wish to carry on a different task then click the ESCAPE option and you will return to the progress or to amend the list of files. TEMPORARY REDEFINING THE COMMANDS:

Strings are stored on any one of 54 icons and these strings can be of any length up to a total of 32k. Strings can be redefined using the install program or just want to re-define a few icons by setting the string variables icc_1\$ to ice_54\$. The last method is useful if you quickly and can be included in your book
